## Eastway Doubles League Rules 2023-24

1. Eastway Doubles will be bowled on Monday Nights with a starting time of 7:10 (warmups from 7pm)
2. Eastway Doubles league will run for 32 weeks starting on August $28^{\text {th }}, 2023$ until April $8^{\text {th }} 2024$.
3. April $15^{\text {th }} \&$ April $22^{\text {nd }}$ will be the roll off (Money Night) for the Eastway Doubles League. Lower half on April $15^{\text {th }}$ and top half on April $22^{\text {nd }}$.
4. Eastway Doubles will be based on a 5 pt system.
a. 1 point per game and 2 points for the overall series
5. Eastway Doubles will be an individually handicapped league.
a. The bases is $90 \%$ of the difference of 210
6. Eastway Doubles will be shooting on 4 different Challenge patterns.
a. $\quad 1^{\text {st }}$ Pattern - Medium
b. $\quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ Pattern - Long
c. $3^{\text {rd }}$ Pattern - Medium
d. $4^{\text {th }}$ Pattern - Short
7. League payment is $\$ 22$ per bowler.
a. $\quad \$ 11$ to the house $\& \$ 11$ to the prize fund
8. The high team handicap series from each week will receive a $\$ 20$ (limit 1 per quarter) party tab and $2^{\text {nd }}$ place receiving a \$10 party tab (also limit of 1 per quarter)
9. If bowling against a "BYE" team, you will need to be within 20 pins of your team average to win the point(s). Tie always goes to the bowler not the "BYE" Team.
10. If bowling without a partner the absent score will be 15 pins off the average of the bowler that is missing. This needs to be the bowler with the most games on the roster that is not there that evening.
11. End of the year roll off for the Eastway Doubles League (based on 20) teams in the league)
a. The top team from each quarter will make the top half roll off.
i. If there are any duplicate teams from any of the 4 quarters bowled, we will take the team(s) who had the most overall wins to fill the spot for the end of the year roll off.
ii. There will be 6 teams that make the top end roll off based on there over all wins at the end of the year to even out the top and bottom half of the roll off.
12. Multiple different prize funds will be created for the teams to vote on the $4^{\text {th }}$ week of bowling.
13. All bowlers who bowled the league in the prior year will bowl their first 9 games in the league under their last year ending average.
a. Any new bowlers to the league will bowl their first 9 games under their last years ending avg converted to a challenge avg.
b. Any bowler bowling a position round must have 9 games in the current year or had bowled in the league last year and have a book average.
14. The team with the most wins overall throughout the season will be the team that chooses the pattern in which the roll-off (money night) will be bowled on.
15. In the event of a tie in a quarter the tiebreaker will be a 1 game roll off bowled on the pattern that was just bowled at least by 2 weeks after period on a fresh pair of lanes at a time decided by both parties.
16. Any tiebreaker in points for the overall seeding of teams for the end of the year roll off will also be a 1 game roll off bowled on the same night as the final position round (week 32). Week 32 will start at $6: 30 \mathrm{pm}$.
a. The final roll off night $(33 \& 34)$ will be bowled at 550 pm warmup and 6 pm start.
17. The winner of the lower half will earn the right to bowl in the Upper halves roll off night as the last seed.
