

Sunday Funday League Rules & Bylaws

General

1. The name of the league shall be the Sunday Funday League.
2. The league shall be sanctioned with the USBC. USBC Sanction fee is \$30.00 per person and due on the first night of bowling (National \$15.00 – Local only \$10.00 and \$5.00 to the state association). This is a handicap league and shall bowl 3 games per night.
3. A legal lineup shall consist of at least 1 male and 1 female physically bowling each night on the 4 person team lineup. If a legal lineup is not bowled an automatic forfeit will take place for that night's points
4. The league will bowl on Sundays at 5:50 warmups and 6:00pm start.
5. The league is based on a 4 quarter system. The 1st quarter will be 8 weeks followed by 3 – 7 week quarters. Position rounds will be the last week of each quarter.
6. **Days Off: Dec 24th, Dec 31st, & Feb 11th**
7. The cost for league bowling shall be \$15.00 per person per night, with \$12.90 going to the bowling center for lineage, and the remaining \$2.10 to go to the league prize fund.
8. Team captains will be responsible for getting full team fees (\$60.00) to the Secretary/Treasurer, prior to the beginning of league play.

Handicap

1. Handicap shall be individually based on 90 percent of the difference of 220.
2. Averages will be established on the first night of bowling and will be used to figure handicap for the first night.
3. When there is an absent bowler, the absent bowler with the most amount of games will be used for figuring the team handicap and the score will be minus 10 pins for that persons handicap score.
4. Late bowlers must be ready to bowl by the 3rd frame of the current game.
5. A team that is short a bowler may use a player from another team's roster as a sub, provided that the sub does not bowl against their own team. Unless the two opposing teams agree to the sub.

Point System

1. The league shall operate on a 4-point system, with 1 point awarded to the winner of each team game and 1 point awarded to the winner of team series. Team standings will be determined by the percentage of wins to losses for each team.
2. When bowling against a missing or Bye team, the team that is present, must bowl within 40 pins of their team average, to receive a winning point.
